



# Shuttle service from airport to track will be available for Brickyard 400 fans

INDIANAPOLIS—Roundtrip shuttle service from Indianapolis International Airport to the Indianapolis Motor Speedway for the Allstate 400 at the Brickyard will be available for \$30 (cash only) on Sunday.

Shuttle service will be provided by Transportation Management Services. Tickets for the air-conditioned, handicapped-accessible shuttles will be sold outside the Ground Transportation Center in Zone 1.

Continuous shuttle loops to the track will run from 8 a.m. until 2 p.m., when the last shuttle departs for the speedway. Return service will run from the speedway to the airport for three hours after the race.

Race fans who want to take advantage of this service should take I-70 to Exit 68 and follow the signs to airport parking. On-airport parking costs range from \$7 in the Economy Parking lot, \$11 in the Long-Term lot, and \$16 in the garage.

Cost for airport parking is NOT included in the \$30 shuttle ticket.

*NOTE: The International Arrivals Building on Pierson Drive will NOT be a pick-up or drop-off point for race fans. All shuttles to the track will be located at the Ground Transportation Center. Take I-70 to Exit 68.*
