From 2000-2007, **MICHAEL B. STAYTON** served as Chief of Staff and Chief Operating Officer for the United Nations World Food Programme, the largest international humanitarian agency in the world. In this role, he oversaw the Office of the Executive Director and from 2003-04, he concurrently served as Deputy Director for Administration, overseeing the WFP's finance, HR, information technology, facilities management, and security operations. Prior to his tenure at WFP, Stayton held positions including President of IWC Industries; President and CEO of SM&P Utility Resources; and Senior Vice President of Energy USA Commercial Group. Director of Public Works & Enterprise Development for the City of Indianapolis from 1993-95, Stayton engaged in venture capital activities from 1980–1993, serving as General Manager and Chief Financial Officer for BioLogicals, Inc.; President of Stayton & Associates, Inc.; Executive Vice President and Director of T.M. Englehart Corp., and founder and investment committee member of Cambridge Ventures, LP. He has served as president of the IAA board since mid-2009.
